MKSU & Chaplaincy organises “HELP ME GROW”

On Saturday 4th April, the Moviment Kattoliku Studenti Universitarji (MKSU) in collaboration with the Chaplaincy of the University of Malta organised its annual “Help Me Grow” activity. The aim of this event is for members of MKSU to put together a social activity for refugees and other Maltese children in Malta. The idea behind “Help Me Grow” is also to encourage young university students to learn how to care for other members of society, with specific reference to the younger generation.

This year MKSU and Chaplaincy thought of giving a dynamic view to the usual annual activity. A group of around 35 children were taken to Razzett tal-Hbiberija, in Marsascala whereby they were able to enjoy a tour round the premises viewing the well-kept animals as well as make use of their playground facilities. Subsequently further animation was organised by the MKSU and Chaplaincy teams in order to provide an enjoyable morning for the children. Help me Grow was made possible through the support of the Eden & Razzett Foundation, who allowed us to use their premises.

MKSU is a Catholic Movement at University with the aim of promoting ‘*Christian Values through Social Commitment*’. It gathers University students, especially those coming from different Catholic groups within the local church in order to express Catholic values and create a just society.
